

Sensys Gatso receives an order from Croatia worth SEK 8.9 million

Sensys Gatso Group, a global leader in traffic safety solutions, has received a purchase order from its local partner in Croatia, Meditronik, for the delivery and maintenance of traffic-safety cameras to the Croatian MOI. The contract between Meditronik and the MOI was signed today. The purchase order to Sensys Gatso has a value of EUR 850 thousand, corresponding to SEK 8.9 million.

Deliveries of the systems, based on the T-series platform, will take place during 2019 and the service agreement is for 6 years. The systems will be used for enforcing speed, mainly on state and municipal roads.

"Sensys Gatso and its partner already have a strong position in Croatia being the biggest supplier of speed cameras. This contract further strengthens our position as the number one supplier of traffic enforcement systems. We are pleased to contribute to improving traffic safety in Croatia", says Stefan Svenningsson, Senior Sales Manager, Sensys Gatso.
